LATERAL TRANSFER

The Town of Hull is seeking highly motivated, experienced police officers for a lateral transfer to our department. The Hull Police Department is a progressive, community-focused department consisting of (30) highly dedicated full-time police officers.

Entrance Requirements: Only permanent civil service police officers from Massachusetts are eligible for transfer under the provisions of Chapter 31, Section 35 of the Massachusetts General Laws. Applicants must have satisfactorily completed a prescribed course of study approved by the Municipal Police Training Committee.

Eligibility Requirements:

All candidates seeking transfer to the Hull Police Department will be required to successfully complete:

- Comprehensive background investigation
- Medical examination to include drug screening
- Psychological examination
- Interviews
- No serious disciplinary issues in the past (5) five years

- Current active unrestricted LTC
- Current active Massachusetts Drivers License

Compensation & Benefits: The current Salary range based on experience is \$57,131.70 to \$67,831.12 (per current C.B.A), plus additional benefits and incentives to include; educational incentive based on degree attained, night & weekend shift differential, longevity bonus, uniform allowance, cleaning allowance, overtime opportunities, multiple stipend opportunities, (13) Holidays, vacation and personal days, and a health insurance program.
